Instructions for Authors

1. Categories of publication

Research articles, reviews, objective descriptions, research reports, opinions/debates, news, letters to editor, meeting report.

2. Cover feature

The covers of *Life Science Journal* feature illustrations the Editor-in-Chief selects from the articles scheduled for publication in that issue. Authors whose articles are chosen for a cover feature will be asked to provide a high-quality version of the selected illustration as well as a brief legend (four to five sentences) describing the significance of the image. In light of the rapid production schedule for journal covers, authors are expected to provide the requested material within 3 days

3. Manuscripts submission

- (1) Submission Methods: Electronic submission through email and on line submission is required.
- (2) Font: Normal, Times New Roman, 10 pt, single space.
- (3) Indent: Type 4 spaces in the beginning of each new paragraph.
- (4) Footnotes: In most instances information should be presented in the text, not in footnotes and Header and Footer.
- (5) Cover Page: Put detail information of authors and a short title in the cover page.
- (6) Title: Use Title Case in the title and subtitles, e.g. "Debt and Agency Costs".
- (7) Figures and Tables: Use full word of figure and table, e.g. "Figure 1. Annual Income of Different Groups", Table 1. Annual Increase of Investment".
- (8) References: Number the references in the order of their first mention in the text. References should include all the authors's last name and initials, title, journal, year, volume, issues, and pages, etc.

Reference Examples:

4. Manuscript preparation

Each manuscript is suggested to include the following components but authors can do their own ways:

- (1) Title : including the complete article title; each author's full name; institution(s) with which each author is affiliated
- (2) Abstract: including Background, Materials and Methods, Results, and Discussions.
- (3) Key Words. On the title page, provide three to five key words identifying the subject of your article.
- (4) Abbreviations. List all the abbreviations needed here, so that they could be used directly in article.
- (5) Introduction.
- (6) Materials and Methods.
- (7) Results.
- (8) Discussions: Explain your interpretation of the data, especially compared with previously published material cited in the References.
- (9) Acknowledgments. List the people indirectly involved with the research to whom you may wish to give thanks. Also, current addresses of authors (if they differ from those in the affiliation line) should be included here.
- (10) Correspondence. Correspondence author's full name, institution, city state/province, zip code, country, telephone number, facsimile number (if available), and email address are listed here.
- (10) References: Authors are responsible for accuracy of citations. References must be limited to directly pertinent published works or papers that have been accepted for publication.

5. Submission fee

US\$50 per printed page of an article to defray costs of the publication will be paid by the authors when it is accepted. Extra expense for color reproduction of figures will be paid by authors (estimate of cost will be provided by the publisher for the author's approval).

6. Distributions

Web version of the journal is freely opened to the world without payment or registration. The journal will be distributed to the selected libraries and institutions for free. US\$100/issue hard copy is charged for the subscription of other readers.
